BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

SB57 appropriates \$300,000 from the general fund to the children, youth and families department to expend in fiscal year 2017 to increase the capacity of programs that provide trauma-informed services to children exposed to domestic violence. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2017 reverts to the general fund.
